Field Notes of the survey of County road No 267

Met the viewers at time and place appointed and under their direction proceed as follows:

I commence at the 1/4 Sec. Cor. for Secs. 29+32 T. 4 N. R. 33 E. - whence roads in lanes run N, E + W. - Set a Cedar post 4x4 ins. 4 ft. long, marked R on S. side in mound of earth on N. side of road, E + W. and run, thence, var. 22° E

80.00 ^{chs.} South on true line through center Section 32; Set post marked 1 M on E. side, about 30 feet west of line - 70 lns N. of road in lane;

80.00 South, on true line through center Sec. 5 T. 3 N. R. 33 E.; Set post marked 11 M on E. side about 30 feet west of line, at Res. of Dr. Harris, on S. side of road in lane E + W.;

80.00 South, on true line through center Sec. 8; Set post marked 111 M on E. side about 30 ft west of line, on S. side of road in lane runs E + W.;

79.00 South, on true line through center Sec. 17; Intersect E + W. line - bet Secs. 17 + 20 - road in lane angles S + E. - Set angle post in mound on west side of traveled road, and turned west on line bet. Secs 17 + 20;

80.00 Set post marked 1 V M, about 30 feet south of line;

78.45 Intersect road in lane at angle - N + W. Set post marked R on E. side.

All the posts are cedar and of the size and marked and mounded as required by law.
