NOW, the condition of the above obligation is such, That, whereas the above named W. H. Bell Joseph Baltezo and Fourteen other and others, have petitioned the County Court of said County of Umatilla at the December Term, 1907, thereof, for a County Road, commencing at the point in the center of County Road No. 578 at Umatilla County, Oregon where said road crosses the East line of the SW quarter of the NE 1/4, of Sec. 17, in Tp. 1 North Range 34 E.W.M. at which point is placed a large stone, the same being about 12ft North of the South East corner of said SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4, of said section 18, thence running Northwesterly and along the most practicable route for a road, a distance of 200 ft. to a mound of stone, with a stake standing in the center thereof; thence running Northeasterly and along the most practicable route for a road a distance of 300ft. to a point on said East line of said South West 1/4 of NE 1/4, said Sec. 17; thence running North to the center of said NE 1/4 of said Sec. 17 thence West to NW cor. said SW 1/4 of NE 1/4, said Sec. 17.

NOW, if the above named W. H. Bell and Joseph Baltezo shall well and truly pay, or cause to be paid, all costs and expenses that may be incurred by reason of the view or review of said Road, in case the prayer of said petitioners be not granted or allowed, then that this obligation shall be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
