TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR
UMATILLA COUNTY:

We, the undersigned Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore
ordered to view the above mentioned proposed county road, submit the
following report;

Pursuant to your order, we met at the beginning point of
the said proposed road on the 25th day of April, 1929 and having
qualified as viewers, proceed to view said road.

We find that the road as petitioned for and described as
follows, Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter
of Section 1, thence running easterly along the quarter section line
to the fence along the top of the bluff, thence running southeasterly
along the top of the bluff to intersect the farm road north of the
Olmsted barn, thence running southeasterly along the farm road and through
the present site of the Olmstead house to the west end of the County
bridge across Little McKay Creek. Said last mentioned point being the
point of ending and is coincident with the point of beginning of County
Road No. 871. All in Township 1 South, Range 32 East, W.M., will be a
feasible and necessary road and a benefit to the public, therefore we
respectfully recommend that it be opened and established as a County
Road of Umatilla County, Oregon.

We find that the lands through which the said road is to be
laid out will be made less valuable by reason of its establishment,
in the amount of the cost of a three wire fence on each side of the
roadway which we recommend be built by Umatilla County and we find
the lands not otherwise damaged or made less valuable.

We further recommend that the Olmstead house be moved by
the Petitioners.
