In the matter of County Road No 554, Commencing running and terminating as follows to-wit:

Commencing at the North Westt Corner of Section Thirtythree Tp. 3 North Range 30, E W M, thence running due South on Sec. line between sections 32 and 33, about 240 rods to where it intersects a road now traveled running diagonally through sec. 33 Tp. 3 North.

R. 30 E W M, and to vacate a Road running diagonally through said sec. 33 Commencing about 80 rods North of the Southwest corner of said sec. 33, said Road running thence in a N. E direction crossing the North Boundary of said sec. 33, at or about the N E Corner of said sec. 33 Tp. 3 N. R. 30 E W M. said Road to be 60 feet wide.

Now on this day comes the report of viewers, J W Kimbrell, F H Beathe, and J B-McDill, heretofore appointed at the November Term of this Court to view out and report upon the location of the above road as a county Road for Final Hearing the same having been read at a previous day of this Term to-wit; The January 1904, Term And the said viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of the same as a County Road and the field Notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the Surveyor appointed to Survey the same and there being no remonstrance of claim for damages on file against said road and the said Viewers having reported that none of the adjoining premises are rendered less valuable by the proposed change it is therefore Ordered by the Court that the report of said Viewers be accepted, and that the said road be established as a County Road in accordance with the report of said viewers, and that the field notes and plat of survey thereof be duly recorded as by law required, and that the Supervisor through whose district said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road.

Now on this day it appearing to the Court that the sureties on the bond of E J Sommerville, heretofore approved, by the Court, are insufficient and that it is necessary for the proper protection of the funds of the County that a new bond be furnished by said E J Sommerville as such County Treasurer.

It is ordered by the Court that said E J Sommerville be and he is hereby ordered and directed to furnish a new official bond in the sum of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000) to be approved by this Court.
