of County Road Viewers for
Road No. 819.

Now on this day this matter coming on to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed to view and report upon said proposed road No. 819 petitioned for as commencing at the quarter Section corner common to Section 12 and 13, Township 4 North Range 29, E.W.M., thence running Northerly and Easterly through Township 4 North, Range 30, E.W.M. by the shortest and most practical route to Station 375/00 of the Cold Springs-Holdman Section of the Pendleton-Cold Springs Highway as the same is now located, said Station 375/00 being in Section 26, Township 5 North, Range 30, E.W.M.; said road to be 60 feet wide; for final hearing, the same having been heretofore publicly read on two different days of this term of court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first day of February, 1922 and publicly read the second time on February 2, 1922; and said board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be established as a county road and that the land over which said road is established will be rendered less valuable in the sum of Nothing.

And there being no remonstrances or objections against said petition or the report of said Viewers and the Court being satisfied that said road will be of public utility and a benefit to the general public,
