

IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR UMATILLA COUNTY.

Now on this day this matter coming on to be heard upon the report of the board of County Road viewers heretofore instructed at the October 1913 term of this Court to view, survey and report upon said proposed road No. 759 petitioned for as commencing at the North east corner of the southeast quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 33, Township 4 North, Range 29 E.W.M. running thence east to a point 20 feet east of the Northeast corner of the southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 34, Township 4 North, Range 29, E.W.M. running thence North to a point 20 feet East of the center of said Section 34, as a County Road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of court to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on November 5th, 1913, and publicly read the second time on November 6th, 1913, and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor who surveyed the same and the board of County Road viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County, and the Court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility it is therefore hereby ordered that said report be approved, and that the plat and field notes be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla County, and that the road supervisor through whose district said road runs be ordered to open said road for public use.
