

IN THE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON  
FOR UMATILLA COUNTY

In the Matter of Vacating a County  
Road running from the SW corner  
of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 7, Township  
4 North, Range 29 to the SE corner  
of Section 6, said township and range.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the February 1918 term of this court to view and report upon said road which is proposed to be vacated, the same having been publicly read on two different days at the same term of court, to wit: having been publicly read the first time on the 6th day of March 1918, and the Court finds that by reason and consideration of the establishment of a county road by the same petitioners, commencing at the Northwest corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 6, Township 4 North, Range 29, and running thence South across the A line Canal, and thence in a Northeasterly direction to the SE corner of Section 6, said Township and Range; that the road herein described, running from the SW corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ -SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 6, to the SE corner of said Section 6, Township 4 North, Range 29 EWM is not needed by the general public and is not of public utility,

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED that said road be closed and vacated.
