

**REPORT OF
BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS**

IN THE MATTER OF VIEWING, SURVEYING AND LAYING OUT
COUNTY ROAD NO. 714

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON, FOR UMATILLA COUNTY.

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed to view, survey, and locate Road No. 714, submit the following report:

Pursuant to an order of the Honorable County Court, we met at the commencement point of said road, on the 25th day of May 1911

who were by the Surveyor each duly sworn. We viewed, surveyed, and located said Road No. 714, as specified in our order. We find said route practicable and would most respectfully recommend that the same be declared and established as a public highway of Umatilla County, Oregon.

The cost of construction will be for one pipe culvert and two bridges about \$ 150.00.

The damage to be sustained by Mr. Tabor by reason of the location and establishment of said road is for moving fence and flume and for damage to and for moving peach trees and locust hedge \$125.00.

The damage to other property owners is nothing.
