It is considered, ordered and adjudged that said report be and the same is hereby approved, that said plat and field notes be recorded in the book of plat and field notes of Umatilla county, that said road be and the same is hereby declared and established a county road as recommended by said report of viewers, and that the road supervisor of said district be and he is hereby instructed to open the same for public travel.

OPENING ROAD No 716

This matter comes on for final hearing upon the report of the board of county road viewers heretofore instructed at the May, 1911, term of this court to view, survey, stake, layout and report upon the cost of opening said proposed road petitioned for as follows:

Commencing at the 1/4 sec corner between sections 21 and 22 T 5 N R 29 E W M, thence west on 1/4 sec line six miles and to the 1/4 sec corner between section 21 and 22 T 5 N R 28 E W M, thence west through said last named sec 21 on 1/4 sec line to the east line of right of way of Huntington line of O W R & N Co railroad and there terminating, said road to be 40 feet wide.

And said report of viewers being duly signed, and the plat and field notes certified by the surveyor and said board finding said route practical and recommending that said petition be granted; that the cost of opening said road for construction of one bridge is \$30.00 and the damages to be sustained by the property owners as follows: Mrs Frank Harrison, \$40.00, Mr Waterman, 440.00, and other property owners nothing, and said report having been publicly read on three different days of the same term of court and there being no remonstrance or objection on file against the same, and the court being advised,

It is therefore ordered that the petitioners pay the cost of constructing said bridge and pay the damages to property owners as follows, Mrs Frank Harrison, 440.00 and Mr Waterman \$40.00 and upon their so doing the said report be approved, the plat and field notes duly recorded, and the said road declared a public highway of Umatilla county, and the road supervisor through whose district said road runs instructed to open the same to public travel.
