In the Matter of opening County Road No. 767, Petitioner for by J.M. Morrison, et al. OPENING COUNTY ROAD NO. 767

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the September 1914, term of this Court to view, survey, stake and lay out said proposed road No. 767, petitioned for as commencing at a point in the center of the county road NO. 570 North 16 degrees East 333 feet from the Southwest corner of Section 7, TP. 2 N.P. 32 E.W.M. thence following in a Southerly direction up Birch Creek, along the most practical route, to a point in the center of the County Road NO. 439, North 34 degrees, fifty minutes West 373 feet from the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 29 TP. 2 N.R. 32 E.W.M. as a County Road, for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on Oct. 7th, 1914, and publicly read the second time on October 8th, 1914, and the said Board Of County Road Viewers, having reported favorably and recommended that said road be established as a County road, and the plat and field notes be recorded in the records of plats and field notes of Umatilla County, and that said road be declared a public highway of Umatilla County; It is further ordered by the court, that the county Court of Umatilla County will not ask for bids for a bridge over the Umatilla river, where said road is to cross the same until such a time as the general public would need such a bridge to such an extent that it would justify the expenditure of such a sum as indicated by the report of viewers on file herein.

In the Matter of County Road No. 768 petitioned for by H.M. Somerer et al, Commencing at N W Corner SW quarter of SW quarter Sec. 33 Tp. 5 N.R. 29 E.W.M ROAD NO. 768

Now on This day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the petition of Henry M. Somerer and 14 other freeholders who are residents of the road district or road districts wherein the hereinafter described and proposed County Road, is to be laid out and established, praying this Court to cause to be laid out and established, a County road commencing at the Northwest corner Southwest quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 33 Tp. 5 N. Range 29 E.W.M. thence East two miles to the Northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 34 TP. 5 N.R. 29 E.W.M and To be 40 feet wide.

And it duly appearing to the Court that due notice of the intended presentation of said petition to this court, has been given by the posting of three notices in the vicinity of said proposed road and that each and all of said notices were securely posted in a public place for full 30 days prior to the date of presentation of said petition to the Court, all as by law required, and the court also finds that said petition is duly and regularly signed by at least 12 freeholders who are residents of the road district or road districts wherein said road is to be established, and there being no remonstrance or objections on file against said petition, it is,

HEREBY ORDERED, that the board of County Road Viewers, to-wit: John W. Kimbrell, Deputy County Surveyor, of Umatilla County, as Surveyor, and W. I. Stockman and L. C. Rothrock as viewers, be and are hereby ordered, to meet in Pendleton, Oregon, on October 19th, 1914, or if unable to meet on that date then within five days thereafter, and proceed to view, survey, stake and lay out said proposed road, and estimate the opening of the same, and make due return of their doings to this Court, at its next regular term. Dated this 8th day of October, 1914.

In the Matter of County Road No. 769 petitioned for by I.M. Allen et al, commencing at Southwest corner, Sec. 31 Tp. 3 North R. 28 E.W.M. ROAD NO. 769

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the petition of I.M. Allen and 26 other freeholders who are residents of the road district or road districts wherein the hereinafter described and proposed County Road is to be laid out and established praying this court to cause to be laid out and established a county road, commencing at the Southwest corner of Section 31 TP. 3 North Range 28 E.W.M. and run thence in a most direct and practical route to the southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest quarter of section 14 said Tp and Range, thence North to the northwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section 14, said Tp. and range, thence East to the Northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 14 said TP. and range; hence North to the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 14, said Tp and range hence East to the Northeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 14, said TP. and range; thence North to the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Sec. 14 said Tp and range, and here terminating; said road to be 50 feet wide.

And the court finds that due notice of the intended presentation of said petition has been given by the posting of three notices in the vicinity of said proposed road and also by the posting of a notice at the North door of the County Court House in Pendleton, Oregon
