Now on this day this matter coming on for final hearing, the same having been publicly read the first time November 22nd, 1923 and publicly read the second time on November 23rd, 1923, said Board finds that owners of land through which said road is to be laid out and established will be made less valuable by reason of establishing said road in the sum of nothing.

The court being of the opinion that said road is of public utility and needed as a part of the general road system of Umatilla County,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said report of the Board of County Road Viewers be approved and that said road be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County, as follows, from the beginning point, described in resolution of this court made on June 8th, 1923, which point is at station 0+00 to station 534 + 50 is a practical road from station 534 + 50 to northerly terminus of said road,

IT IS ORDERED that the route described in said report be changed as following revised location of the Oregon Washington Highway as adopted by the Oregon State Highway Commission. Said revised location being described as follows:

Begining at Station 534 + 50 P.O.T. of the survey as described in your resolution,
