

## Field Notes of Road Survey No. 422, for Umatilla County Oregon

James Frank Frazier and J. A. Howard, viewers on Road No. 422 for Umatilla County Oregon, and administer to each the usual Road Viewers' Oath; we call Edgar R. Thomson and Frank Vincent to chain and mark, who, each, duly made oath according to law. After which, under direction of said viewers, I set initial post against fence on west side of county road No. 397, and 20 ft. N. of intersection with line bet. secs. 16 & 21, T. 2 N. R. 32 E, about 360 ft. west of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. on said sec. line.

West  
 35' From said point of intersection I run on sec. line.  
 Foot of hill.  
 200' Willow trees; center of lane, on sec. line, near small bridge.  
 880' E. side of M'Kay creek 130' wide, on line, course N. W. Should be bridged about 150'.  
 1010' W. side of M'Kay creek.  
 1475' Cor. fences, E. S. W. & N. W. Intersect road leading from Pendleton, via. of "Lower bridge" on M'Kay c'k. to Lee's crossing on Birch creek.  
 Set terminus against fence 20' N. of line bet. secs. 16 & 21 in sandy bottom.

All the posts used are of proper size and are correctly marked and set in mounds.
