In the Matter of Approval of Plat of Livermore's Second Addition to the City of Pendleton, Oregon

Now on this day this matter coming on for hearing and it appearing to the Court that the plat of Livermore's Second Addition to the City of Pendleton as here exhibited is in all things lawful and regular and should be approved, It is therefore ordered that said plat be, and the same hereby is approved.

In the Matter of County Road No. 770 Petitioned for by Jos. A. Monese, et al.

ROAD NO. 770

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed at the February 1915 term of this Court to view, survey, stake and lay out said proposed road No. 770 petitioned for by as follows: Commencing at a point 14 rods north of the southwest corner of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 15, Twp. 3 N.R. 29 E.W.M. running thence North-easterly on the East side of the ravine to a point twenty rods East of the Northwest corner of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 15, Twp. 3 N.R. 29 E.W.M. and there terminating, said road to be sixty feet wide as the county road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court. And the same board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor who surveyed the same and the Court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility and there being no remonstrance or objection on file against said report it is hereby ordered by the court that said report of the board of County Road Viewers be approved and that the same be recorded in the records of plats and field notes of Umatilla County and that the road supervisor through whose district said road runs be and he is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use.

In the Matter of County Road No. 771 Petitioned for by Corey Harris, et al.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed at the February 1915 term of this Court to view, survey, stake and lay out said proposed road No. 771 petitioned for as follows: Commencing at the Southwest corner of Sec. 31, Tp. 3 N.R. 28 E.W.M. and running thence in the most direct and practical route to the southeast corner of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 14, Tp. 3 N.R. 28 E.W.M. thence north to the NW corner of the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 14, same township and range, thence east to the NE corner of the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 14, same township and range, thence North to the NW corner of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of said Sec. 14, same township and range, where the proposed road would intersect the present county road, said road to be 40 feet wide as the county road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court. And the same board of County road viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor who surveyed the same and the Court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility and there being no remonstrance or objection on file against said report, it is hereby ordered by the court that said report of the board of County Road viewers be approved and that the same be recorded in the records of plats and field notes of Umatilla County and that the road supervisor through whose district said road runs be and he is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use.

In the Matter of vacating County Road No. 327.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the County Road Viewers heretofore instructed at the February 1915 term of this court to view, survey, and report upon said road which is proposed to be vacated, petitioned for as follows: Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of Section 15, Twp. 3 N.R. 29 E.W.M. thence East and Northerly to a point eighty rods East of the Northwest corner of Section 14, Twp. 3 N.R. 29 E.W.M. and there terminating for the vacating of a County Road for final hearing the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of Court, and the said Board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be vacated at such a time when County Road NO. 770 shall have been established and opened to the general public and that the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor who surveyed the same, and there being no remonstrance or objections on file against said report and the court being satisfied that said road is not of sufficient public utility, It is therefore hereby ordered that said report of the Board of County Road Viewers be approved and that said road be vacated and that the plat and field notes be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla County and that the Road Supervisor through whose district said road is now established be and he is hereby ordered and instructed to close the same to public travel.
