ROAD NO. 753.

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the August Term 1913, of this court to review, said proposed road No. 753 petitioner for as follows: Commencing at a point 9 rods north of the Northwest corner of the southeast quarter of section 29 Tp 2 N.R. 32 E.W.M. running thence in a southeasterly direction over the most practical route, to a point 43 rods north of the center of the Northeast quarter of section 4 in Tp 1 N.R. 32 E.W.M. thence in an easterly and southerly direction over the most practical route to a point 20 rods east of the center of the northeast quarter of Section 4, Tp. 1 N.R. 32 E.W.M. and to be 40 feet wide, as a county road, for final hearing, the same having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of court, to-wit: having publicly read the first time on Sept 3rd 1913, and publicly read the second time on Sept. 4th, 1913, and the said Board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be declared and established as a county road, and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor who surveyed the same and the court being now satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility, and there being no objection on file, except that one, Alex Hudson has filed herein a claim for damages in the sum of \$250.00, and the court having considered said report and the claim of Alex Hudson, it is HEREBY ORDERED, that said report of the board of County road viewers, be approved and that the plat and field notes be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla County, and the Road Supervisor through whose district said road runs, is hereby ordered to open said road for public use, and that the claim of Alex Hudson for damages be allowed in the sum of \$50.00 the latter sum to be paid by Umatilla County
