KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Jerry Eaton and Dora Eaton, his wife of the County of Umatilla in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One & no/100 Dollars paid them the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by them have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, State of Oregon, to-wit:

A strip of land for Highway purposes 60' wide over and across the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Twp. 1 N. R. 29 E. W. M., the center line of which is described as commencing at a point 565' N of the corner common to Sections 29, 30, 31 and 32 twp. 1 N. R. 29 E. W. M. thence S. 67° 08' E. A distance of 1272.6'; thence around a 10° curve to the left, the long cord of which bears S. 73° 38' E., a distance of 130' thence S 80° 08' E. a distance of 42.4' more or less to the N and S center line running through the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32 Twp. 1 N. R. 29 E. W. M., which point is the beginning of this description, thence continuing on the bearing of S. 80° 08' E., a distance of 258.8'; thence around a 6° curve to the right the long cord of which bears S. 72° 23' E., a distance of 258.6'; thence S.

64° 37' E. a distance of 407.6'; thence around a 10° curve to the right the long cord of which bears S. 48° 08' E., a distance of 329.7', thence S. 31° 39' E. a distance of 747.5', thence around a 26° curve to the left the long cord of which bears S. 61° 39' E. a distance of 230.8', thence N. 88° 21' E., a distance of 321', thence around a 16° curve to the right the long cord of which bears S. 55° 34' E. a distance of 450.9', thence S. 19° 30' E., a distance of 653.8', thence around a 2° curve to the left the long cord of which bears S. 20° 55' E., a distance of 141.7', thence S. 22° 20' E. a distance of 312.6', thence around a 4° curve to the right a distance of 110.3' more or less to the E. and W. center line through Section 32. RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT

The Grantors Beryl D. Grilley and Donald Grilley, wife and husband. of Marion County, Oregon for and in consideration of Twenty and 00/100 DOLLARS, in hand paid, hereby grant to PACIFIC POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors and assigns, an easement or right-of-way for an electric transmission and distributing line of one or more wires and all necessary or desirable appurtenances (including telephone and telegraph wires, towers, poles, props, guys and other supports and including the right to place all said lines in underground conduits) at or near the location and along the general course now located and staked out by the Grantee over, across and upon the following described premises, located in Umatilla County, Oregon to-wit:

Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section Five (5), Township Two North (2N), Range Thirty-two (R32) E. W. M. This pole line will follow a line approximately four feet south from the north line of the above described property.

Together with the right of ingress and egress over the adjacent lands of the grantors for the purpose of constructing, reconstructing, stringing new wires on, maintaining and removing said lines and appurtenances and exercising other rights hereby granted.

All rights hereunder shall cease when said lines have been abandoned.
