Clark, heretofore appointed viewers at the November, 1899, term of this Court, to view out and assess the damages to the lands of Jacob Mc Reynolds, A. H. Mc Reynolds and C. N. Mc Reynolds by reason of the location of County Road No. 512, described as follows, to-wit; commencing Eighty rods West of the center of Section four, Township Five South Range Thirty-two East Willamette Meridian, thence one and one-fourth miles west, thence one-fourth mile south, thence one-half mile west; thence one-quarter mile south; thence one mile west; thence about 200 rods south to the present traveled road, thence along the traveled road to intersect with the east end of Well street in the town of Ullrich, Umatilla County, Oregon, said road to be forty feet wide. Said viewers assessing the damages to the lands of said Jacob Mc Reynolds at \$32.<sup>00</sup>, assessing the damages to the lands of said A. H. Mc Reynolds at \$32.<sup>00</sup>, and assessing the damages to the lands of the said C. N. Mc Reynolds at \$15.<sup>00</sup>; and it appearing to
