NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey was to establish the boundaries of a 10 by 12 foot easement being acquired by Pacific Northwest Bell. The easement is located adjacent to the South right-of-way of Bridge Road and the East right-of-way of Walker Road.

The Northwest corner of Section 18 is a stone with a Brass Cap over it. The North line of Section 18 was established by tying to the Northeast corner of the section which is a 1 1/2" iron pipe as shown on Umatilla County Surveyor Drwg. No. H-142-B. The West line of Section 18 was established from a survey by Dennis Edwards, Umatilla County Surveyor Drwg. No. R-39-B. The 20 foot rights-of-way were confirmed with the Umatilla County Road Department.

Bearings are based upon Umatilla County Surveyor Drwg. No. R-39-B showing the West line of Section 18 bearing N0°18'08"E.
