



NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey was to establish the boundaries of that parcel of land belonging to the DeMott's Family Partnership as recorded on Roll 95, Page 94 of the Umatilla County Deed Records and to portion off four acres therefrom. Bearings are based on a survey by Wayne Harris for Strout Realty dated 11-26-75, Umatilla County Surveyor No. K-15-A. The breakdown of Section 24 was accomplished by ties to the NW and SW corners of said Sec. 24 which are stones with scribed "x"s, and ties to the N 1/16 C-C and the S 1/16 C-C of said Sec. 24 as shown on said Wayne Harris survey, Co. No. K-15-A.
