**NARRATIVE OF SURVEY**

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO ESTABLISH THE C-W 1/16 CORNER OF SECTION 29. ACCEPTABLE MONUMENTATION WAS FOUND FOR REQUIRED CORNERS AS INDICATED ON THIS PLAT. ALTHOUGH NOT REQUIRED FOR THIS SURVEY, OBSERVED BEARINGS AND DISTANCES ARE ALSO SHOWN BETWEEN THE SE. CORNER AND S 1/4 CORNER, AND BETWEEN THE S 1/4 CORNER AND CENTER 1/4 CORNER.

BASIS OF BEARINGS IS AS INDICATED ON THIS PLAT.

MEASUREMENTS WERE MADE WITH 20 SECOND THEODOLITE AND INFRA RED DISTANCE MEASURING EQUIPMENT.
