CORNER DESIGNATION: Z-19. South 1/4 corner Section 35, T1N., R35E., W.M.

PREVIOUS RENEWALS/SURVEYS, ETC.: Most recent approved GLO Survey was made by James P. Currin and James Noland, under Special Contract dated May 4, 1887. Notes state: "Set post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground in exact place of old cor. for 1/4 sec. cor., marked S.C. 1/4 S. on N. face, from which: A Spruce, 8 ins. in diam. bears N.10°E.40 lks. dist., marked S.C. 1/4 S.B.T. A Spruce, 8 ins. in diam. bears S.40°E. 20 lks. dist., marked S.C. 1/4S B.T. These are the original bearing trees." References to old corner and accessories are from original corner establishment by Timothy Davenport, Contract No. 102, dated July 20, 1863.

MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND:
Rotten spruce stump with visible scribing bears S 40° E-20 LK (13.2 feet).

MONUMENT SET:

At a point N 40° W- 20 LK (13.2 feet) from remains of original bearing tree, set a 2 1/2" brass cap on 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe, 28" in the ground with mound of earth to cap, (cap marked as shown in monument detail).

New Accessories:

Set steel fence post 1.6 feet North of monument with witness sign attached.

A 12" spruce bears N 61° W-15.9 feet, scribed: 1/4 S35 SC BT.
A 10" spruce bears N 32° W-22.7 feet, scribed: 1/4 S35 SC BT.
A 16" tamarack bears N 09° E-37.2 feet, scribed: 1/4 S35 SC BT.
A 19" tamarack bears N 22° E-23.6 feet, scribed: 1/4 S35 SC BT.
Bearing trees have a brass washer stamped 'PLS 1106' nailed to the face of the blaze. Attached bearing object and witness signs to each tree, painted a 6" band and face of blaze red.
