Description of Corners:Set a post 4' long, 4" sq., $24^{\prime \prime}$ in ground for cor. to Sec 17 18,19,20, marked T1N S 17 on NE, R36E S 20 on SE, S 19 on SW \& S 18 on NW face with 3 notches on $S$ \& 5 notches on E edges, from which a pine $6^{\prime \prime}$ dia bears N450 E 11 lks marked T1N R36E S17 BT, ta pine $28^{\prime \prime}$ dia bears S $60^{\circ}$ E 25 lks marked T1N R36E S20 BT a fir $4^{\prime \prime}$ dia beấrs S250 W 22 ks marked T1N R36E S19 BT a fir $7^{\prime \prime}$ dia bears N35 ${ }^{\circ} \mathrm{W} 89$ lks marked

The corner was searched for by following a down fence line from the Horseshoe Ridge Rd No. N-208 in an easterly direction for as much as a $1 / 4$ mile, traversing back \& forth across the fence line \& its projection

No evidence of the corner was found.
There was evidence of an old fire having been in the area which may have destroyed the bearing trees.
