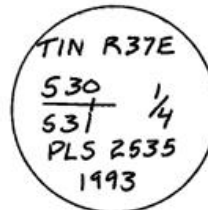
1882 Herman Gradon, set a basalt stone 18"x7"x5", 12" in the ground, marked with a 1/4 on the north face, from which;
12" pine bears N.35°W., 18.5 feet scribed per manual of instruction.
7" fir bears S.10°E., 14.5 feet scribed per manual of instruction.

Monument(s) & Accessories Found: (Condition and Source)

At a record topo call distance from the creek (4.5 chains) I found a 21" douglas fir badly decayed with a healed face facing in the proper direction for the original fir which is in the southeast quadrant. I chopped into the face, at the proper 7" diameter, I found a hardened face that was decayed beyond recognition of any scribe marks. There was an axe mark at the lower portion of this face. This position is consistent with the short 1/2 mile distances (2570') that I have retraced between found section corners on the east and west section line.

Monument Set (Procedures and Description)

At a record bearing and distance pull from the original southeast bearing tree, I set a 3-1/4" aluminum cap on a 2-1/2"x 30" aluminum pipe, 25" in the ground, with a land survey monument sign attached to a steel post nearby.

New Accessories

18" ponderosa pine bears S.82-1/2°W., 27.9 feet scribed 1/4S31BT.
21" ponderosa pine bears S.45°E., 38.9 feet scribed 1/4S31BT.
1-1/2" aluminum cap (PLS 2535) on a 5/8"x 24" rebar bears N.19-1/2°E., 17.7 ft, cap is stamped 17.7 RM with an arrow pointing toward the corner.
1-1/2" aluminum cap (PLS 2535) on a 5/8"x 24" rebar bears N.71°W., 18.4 feet, cap is stamped 18.4 RM with an arrow pointing toward the corner.

I painted a 6" red band around all bearing trees and attached a bearing tree sign on the front with a land survey monument sign on the back. On the new bearing trees I attached a brass washer "PLS 2535" in the BT portion of the blaze.
