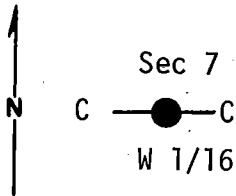

Corner set from survey at location determined by subdivision of section.

A 12" White Fir, scribed "CW1/16 S7 BT" on a double blaze bears S56<sup>0</sup>W 24.5 ft. Attached brass washer marked "LS 1099" to lower blaze of each BT. Placed steel fenceposts 5' S and E of monument with signs 54-2 and 54-9 attached. Attached signs and painted BT's per Standard Specifications for Cadastral Survey U.S.F.S. Region 6, October 1979.
