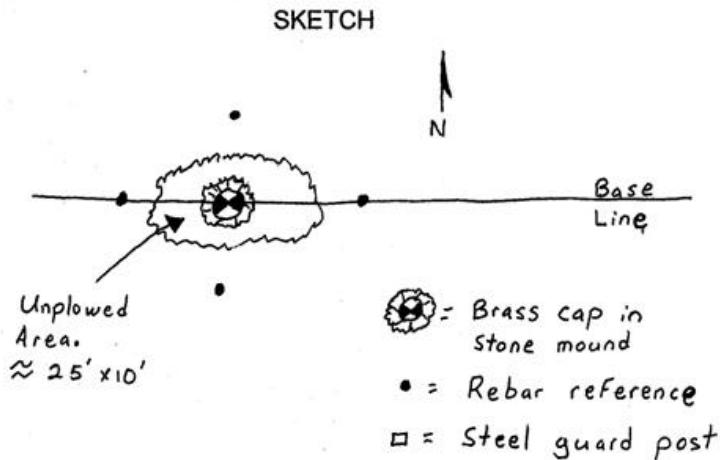
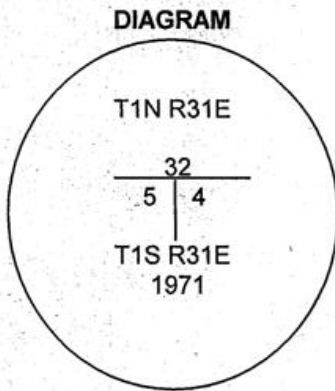

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

The corner was originally set by David P. Thompson under contract No. 106 dated August 16, 1864. His record reads: Set stone 18 x 15 x 8 in. for corner to secs. 4 & 5. The County Surveyor, Aubrey Perry, in the survey recorded in Book 2, Page 301 of the Record of Private Surveys records the original stone had been moved and the marks were not plain. He said "Reset rock on line for Sec. 4-5-S marked II on W - IIII on E." In County Survey H-7-B, Donald Staebler, Engineer 5408, said "Found stone. Set Brass Cap."

Monument and Accessories found: ( condition and source )

The brass cap set by Staebler in a mound of stone with a steel guard post and monument sign along side.



**MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)**

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1 1/4" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852, and WAL5 13922 as described below:

- an iron rebar bears N0°10'12"E, 23.62 feet, 18" below the surface;
- an iron rebar bears S84°10'43"E, 23.87 feet, 18" below the surface;
- an iron rebar bears S1°51'36"W, 24.31 feet, 18" below the surface;
- an iron rebar bears N89°12'04"W, 25.63 feet, 18" below the surface;

The monument and references were tied using a LIECA SYSTEM 300 RTK GPS.
