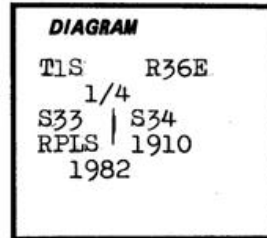


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:
Corner established in 1882 by Herman D. Gradon
under contract No. 452
5" diam. Tamarack at Corner, marked 1/4S on West face
Tamarack, 5" diam., S.45°E., 9 links, marked 1/4SBT
Tamarack, 5" diam., N.40°W., 13 links, marked 1/4SBT
Note: No restoration notes appear in county records



Description of corner evidence found:

Found axe work on old burned face, which I took to be the Southeast bearing tree.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2 1/2" diam. brass cap in a 2"X30" iron pipe at record bearing and distance from bearing tree.
