

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

T 2N, R 32E., W.M.

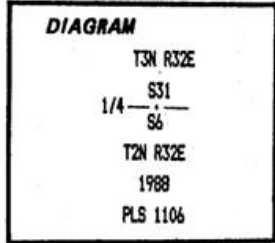

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by D. Thompson, U.S. Deputy Surveyor under Contract No. 106 dated August 16, 1864. The original notes state that at the corner a 20" by 10" by 4" stone was set for the corner.

In 1904, Surveyor John Kimbrell declared the original corner stone lost and according to his record of County Survey No. 212, set stone for 1/4 corner marked 1/4.



Corner No. Compass Declination: 18.0

Description of corner evidence found:

Found 20" by 12" by 8" basalt stone, firmly set 14" in the ground. No marks were visible on the stone. (The stone broke in half when it was removed to set the new monument). No trace of any charcoal was found below this stone and the found stone is believed to be the corner stone set by John Kimbrell in 1904. Traces of the earth berm from a very old east-west fence run east-west through the corner stone. Faint traces of an old earth berm from a north-south fence exist about 8 feet west of the corner stone.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner:

At the position of the found corner stone, I set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/2" by 30" galv. iron pipe 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. Buried corner stone in the new mound. Set two reference monuments to reference the new monument. From the new corner monument:

A 1 1/2" yellow plastic cap marked "W.R. Wells, PLS 1106", set on a 5/8" by 30" iron rod bears N 6 1/2° W 13.31'.

A 1 1/2" aluminum cap, marked as shown, set on a 5/8" by 30" iron rod, bears N83° E 16.28'.

Set steel fence post with witness corner sign attached west of corner monument. Set steel fence posts with witness corner and bearing object signs attached near each reference monument.

The aluminum cap on the reference monument is marked as follows:
