

ARTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

T 2N, R 32E., W.M.

Corner Code No. N-9

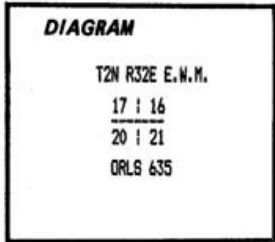

History of original corner establishment:

Most recent approved GLO record, by Currin and Noland, under Special Contract dated May 4, 1887 states:

"Repaired old corner. Set a post 4 ft. long 4 ins. square 24 ins. in ground marked 12N S16 on N.E., R32E. S21 on S.E., S20 on S.W. and S17 on N.W. faces with 5 notches on S. edges. Dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. in each Sec. 5 1/2 ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high 4 1/2 ft. base alongside".

County records indicate a rock crib and iron pipe in place for the corner prior to 1886. Since 1977, record surveys have indicated a brass capped iron pipe monument at the corner point. The brass cap monument has been used on all recorded surveys in the area.

Compass Declination: 18.0°

Description of corner evidence found:

A 2-1/2" Brass cap on a 1" iron pipe, protruding 8" out of ground, at the West edge of an intersection of a North - South and East fences. There is a 2" galv. iron pipe, 1.1 feet Southwest of the corner, with an illegible sign attached.

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set steel fence post with a Witness Corner sign attached, set 3.0 feet South. Built stone mound around corner. From the corner monument:
A brass washer nailed to power pole no. 209960 brs. N 78°W - 4.40'. Brass washer is stamped "PLS 1106". Placed bearing object sign on the pole.
A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears S 38°W - 18.12', capped with a yellow plastic cap marked "W.R. WELLS, PLS 1106".
A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears S 11 1/2°E - 18.00', capped with a yellow plastic cap marked "W.R. WELLS, PLS 1106".
A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears N 34°E - 20.00', capped with a yellow plastic cap marked "W.R. WELLS, PLS 1106".

Set a 5.5 foot steel fence post, on rough line, approximately 1 foot from each pin, with a Bearing Object information sign attached.
