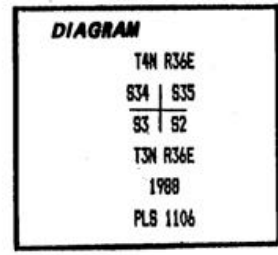

**History of original corner establishment:**

This corner was originally established by Odell and Lewis, U. S. Deputy Surveyors, under Contract No. 110, dated February 7, 1865. The original notes state that at the corner a wood post was set from which

- A 20" fir bears N2°E 40 lks.
- A 3" fir bears S57°W 25 lks.
- A 3" fir bears S57°W 25 lks.
- A 24" fir bears East 28 lks.

**Description of corner evidence found:**

Fence lines running North-South and West.

**Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

Accepted fence corner with fences running North-South and West as the best remaining evidence of the original corner position after measuring to corners to the East, West, and North. At the reestablished corner position, set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/2" by 30" galv. iron pipe 24" in the ground and surrounded with a mound of earth and stone. From the reestablished corner position:

- A 16" douglas fir bears S15°E 162.5' scribed T3N R36E S2 BT.
- A 10" western larch bears S20°W 35.4' scribed T3N R36E S3 BT.
- A 11" douglas fir bears N57°W 45.3' scribed T4N R36E S34 BT.
- No tree available in Northeast quadrant.

Attached bearing object signs to each bearing tree and set a steel fence post South of corner and attached witness corner sign.
