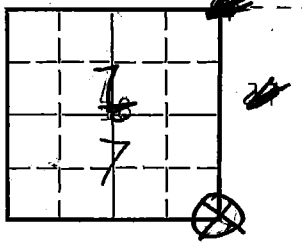

4. Description of Corners: Original corner not found. Re-survey set a Basalt stone 18 x 10 x 5 on west side of spur for corner. Sections 7, 8, 17 & 18. A fir 18" in di. brs. S 52° west 108 lks dist.
 No other trees near. 1879

5. Investigation Notes: Found metal pipe 1/2" di. 18" long in good condition marked with orange ribbon and metal tag between pipe and rock. From pipe S 52° W 108 lks. brs. a dead fir in creek bottom which is the old B.T. All scribing destroyed except for part of one letter - O

Metal pipe is on open west hillside. Closest tree is the dead fir in creek bottom (B.T.). Route is by going up draw across road from Baker's trailer house. First dead fir you come to is the B.T. which is approx. 4 ch. from road.
