4. Description of Corners: Found, at corner of sec. $16 \& 17$, a Basalt Stone $16 \times 12 \times 7$ inches on N.W. face of spur, marked and witnessed as described by surveyor - general. At the point of intersection, ( 89 links N $89^{\circ} 45^{\prime} \mathrm{E}$ from sec $16 \& 17$ corner) I set a basalt stone $12 \times 12 \times 5$ inches, 8 inches in the ground for (see remarks)
5. Investigation Notes: Found stone $12 \times 12 \times 5$ six inches above ground in good condition marked with 4 groves on east and 2 groves on west sides, with a $3 \frac{1}{2}$ by $2 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime}$ post driven in ground beside it. Found blazed trees within area. One fir had a $K$ tag. No sign of any B.Ts. Area has been logged.

I followed tree blazes in from creek bottom to the sec. cor. which was well marked. I put silver paint on Basalt stone and orange ribbon on post. Placed a do not destroy sign on $16^{\prime \prime}$ fir which is approx. 10-12' from stone. Placed new $K$ tag on $6^{\prime \prime}$ fir that is used for sub. pt. Best route in is by following blazed trees from creek bottom.
Used a $6^{\prime \prime}$ fir as sub. pt. The bearing to sec. for is $568^{\circ}$ W 85'.
