

**OREGON CORNER RESTORATION FORM**

CORNER DESIGNATION: 4N31J-03, The North Quarter Corner of Section 18.

PREVIOUS RENEWALS/SURVEYS ETC.: Corner established by Wm. H. Odell, under Contract No. 114, Dated July 2 1866. Record states: Set 1/4 Sec. post Cor.; drove charred stake, dug pits & raised mound as per instructions.

MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND: None. There is a old North South fence through corner area.

MONUMENT SET: Holding old North-South fence line for departure, I re-establish this corner position at it's intersection with a line between the Northeast and Northwest corners of Section 18. At re-established corner position, set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe, 30" in the ground, marked as shown in Monument Marking Detail.

**New accessories:**

- A 5/8" x 24" rebar with a 1 1/4" yellow plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372" bears North, 43.1 feet.
  - A 5/8" x 24" rebar with a 1 1/4" yellow plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372" bears North, 19.9 feet.
  - A 5/8" x 24" rebar with a 1 1/4" yellow plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372" bears South, 9.6 feet.
  - A 5/8" x 24" rebar with a 1 1/4" yellow plastic cap marked "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372" bears South, 32.5 feet.
- Nailed a "witness" sign to wood fence post 10 feet South of corner. Rebar accessories have bearing object signs attached. Rebar accessories are in old North-South fence line.

LOCATION AND COMMENTS: Corner is in North-South fence about 150 feet South of draw with road in it.
