

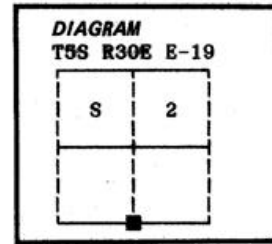
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by George S. Pershin under GLO contract number 430, dated 1882. Surveyer General record states:

Set basalt stone 20x13x5 ins 15 ins in ground for 1/4 sec cor marked 1/4 on N. face; from which,

A Pine 5 ins dia brs S10°E, 38 lks dist. marked 1/4S BT
A fir 10 ins dia brs N24°E, 8 lks dist marked 1/4S BT



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Umatilla County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found stone 16x11x5 inches marked 1/4 lying loose on the ground at record distance from the creek call to the East of the corner.

Found no evidence of either original bearing tree. The area has been heavily logged and torn up.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: In place of the found original corner stone, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 20 inches in the ground, from which:

New BTs:

A 33 inch diameter White Fir bears S32°W, 14.55 feet marked 1/4 S11 BT
A 14 inch diameter Western Larch bears N45°W, 83.18 feet marked 1/4 S2 BT

Raised a mound of stone around monument, 3 ft. base to top of cap.

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs. Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet East with property boundary and land survey monument signs attached.

Buried the original corner stone West and alongside of monument.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on August 30, 1988.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 17° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
