

## CORNER RECORD (PERPETUATION)

MONUMENT: DESCRIBE NEW MONUMENT SET, OR WORK DONE TO PWESERVE EXISTING MONUMENT
Set a $2^{\prime \prime} \times 30^{\prime \prime}$ galvanized iron pipe with a brass cap 29" in ground marked: TSS R3IE Set steel fence posts South and West of corner on SW $1 / 16$ S 19 property line and attached signs 54-2 and 54-9.

ESTABLISHED, OR WORK DONE TO PRESERVE ÉXISTING EVIDENCE A 11" red fir bears N86² 116.2 ft . to center, marked SW $1 / 16 \mathrm{~S} 19 \mathrm{BT}$. A 912" Tamarack bears N35 ${ }^{\circ} \mathrm{W} 41.9 \mathrm{ft}$. to center, marked SW $1 / 16 \mathrm{~S} 19$ BT. BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54-3 and 34i4 and painted red ring around BT's.

Note: This corner was established in error in 7/79 and bearing trees esitablished. When the corner was established in its true position, scribing and signs were removed, from one BT referencing the erroneous position. From the correct corner position: A $9 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ red fir bears $589^{\circ} \mathrm{E} 87.8 \mathrm{ft}$, with open blaze.
