
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

No record of previous monumentation.



Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ 'x30" alum. pipe with a 3" alum. cap containing a magnet and marked:

SW 1/16 S2 PLS 1832 1984

Built a stone mound around the monument.

From the corner:

A P. Pine, 10" dia., N63½°E, 46.2 ft. marked: SW 1/16 S2 BT A P. Pine, 10" dia., S61½°E, 61.9 ft. marked: SW 1/16 S2 BT

BTs have blaze and a 6" stripe painted red, a BT tag, a "Land Survey Monument" sign and an alum. <code>'PLS</code> 1832" washer nailed to the bottom of the blaze. There is a 6' steel fence post with a "Land Survey Monument" sign within 5' of the corner.

Measured to center of BTs using steel tape and staff compass. Magnetic declination set at 17 $3/4^{\circ}\text{E}$.
