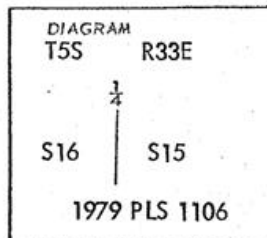


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established by George S. Pershin under Contract No. 430, dated March 23, 1882. The original notes state that at the corner a 4 inch square by 3 foot long was set in a mound of stone. No bearing trees were established.



No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County Records .  
Description of corner evidence found:

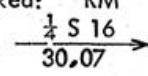
No evidence of original monument. Corner re-established by survey.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the corner position a 2 inch by 30 inch iron pipe, with brass cap marked as shown, was set 10 inches in the ground and surrounded with a mound of stones to the cap .

Set steel fence post on section line N of corner and attached signs 54-2 and 54-4.  
Established 1 new BT: A 12 1/2" bull pine bears S63°E 123.0 ft scribed 1/4 S15BT  
Established 1 reference monument; Set 2" x 30" iron pipe with brass cap for reference monument (RM) set 20" in ground to rock and surrounded with stone, bears N89°W 30.07 ft. marked: RM

New BT has a lower blaze scribed BT with brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-4 and painted red ring around all BT's.

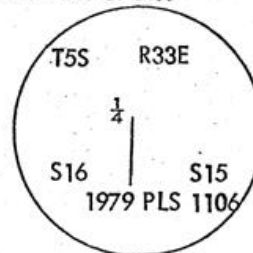


Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 19 1/2° east declination. Measured to center of Bts.
