
West 1/16, Sec. 9 and 16, T. 5 S., R. 34 E., W.M.

History of original corner establishment:

The West 1/16, Sec. 9 and 16, T. 5 S., R. 34 E., W.M. was originally monumented by James H. Hambleton (JHH) L.S. #645, in August, 1978. JHH's record states: "I set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 30" galv. iron pipe, and being stamped as shown above, in a large mound of stone and dirt which buried the monument."



Description of corner evidence found:

I found a 2 1/2" diam. brass cap on a 2 1/2" galvanized iron pipe, 2" below the surface of the ground, marked T5S

From which: JHH BT's:

A stump, of a Lodgepole Pine, 7" (7") diam., bears $N53^{\circ}E$ ($N50^{\circ}E$), a distance of 18.4 ft. (18.25 ft.).

Pieces of a Lodgepole Pine log, loose, 6" (6") diam., bears N36 $^{\rm O}$ W (N35 $1/2^{\rm O}$ W), a distance of 23 ft. (23.33 ft.), scribed "/16S9 BT" visible, and brass washer marked "LS 645" nailed below the "BT".

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

From the existing brass cap I established the following new BT's: A Lodgepole Pine, 6" diam., bears N61°E, a distance of 5.3 ft., scribed "XBT", with a brass washer marked "LS 2211" nailed between the B & T.

A Lodgepole Pine, 8" diam., bears N25 $^{\rm O}$ W, a distance of 28.2 ft., scribed "W 1/16 S9 BT", with a brass washer marked "LS 2211" nailed between the B & T.

The brass cap is in a stone collar, which we re-build.

Set or reset steel fence posts: North 5 ft., and East 2.6 ft.

A cabin and 2 out buildings bear \$40°W, about 300 ft.

DOG HAIR LODGEPOLE

Property Boundary Conditions

A portion of Dog Hair Lodgepole, Units 1 & 2, maybe contiguous to the north-south center line of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 9, Township 5 South, Range 34 East, W.M., Union County, Oregon. This line was originally established by James Hambleton, LS 645, in 1978, based on evidence of the 1882 GLO survey by Rufus S. Moore.

We found the West 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 9 & 16 and the Center West 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 9. as established by Hambleton. Also we found the property boundary post between these two monuments. Maintenance work consisted of replacing signs on the boundary posts which had been rubbed off by cattle. In addition one new bearing tree was scribed at the C-W 1/16 and two were taken at the W 1/16.

As the work was accomplished we noted a "fence of convenience" which is located easterly from the property boundary (perhaps 100 feet on the north end and several hundred feet on the south).
