**MOUNUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND:**

**MOUNUMENT AND ACCESSORIES SET:**

Set 1½" galvanized iron pipe with a 2½" brass cap, 6" SW of ancient post and 6" NE of fence  
corner with top 4" exposed, from which:

A 5/8" x 30" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap "TLS-HDJ" bears N32°E, 37.70 feet distance.

A 5/8" x 30" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap "TLS-HDJ" bears N45°W, 49.00 feet distance.

A 5/8" x 30" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap "TLS-HDJ" bears S19°E, 22.40 feet distance.

A 5/8" x 30" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap "TLS-HDJ" bears S67°W, 36.20 feet distance,  
with tag on fence post over this rebar.

Set witness tag on T-Post bearing N68°W, 1.50 feet distance.
