At the corner position, we set a 2 " $\times 30$ " Galvanized Iron Pipe 14" in the ground to bedrock and supported in a mound of stone 6' dia. base to top of pipe, with brass cap attached, marked:

Attached brass washer, marked "LS 1099" to lower blaze of new BT's.
