

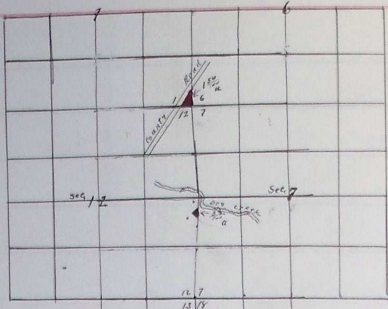

thence I run South on same line

39 97 a point 41 lks west and 29 lks north of Stone $\frac{1}{4}$ by J C Arnold as
Deputy County Surveyor under W. J. Chalk County Surveyor in 1885

44 21 the plank fence course $S 44^{\circ} 30' W$ 181 lks and $N 6^{\circ} 52'$ to same line bet corner
50 96 fence $N 46^{\circ} W$ 180 lks and $S 46^{\circ} E$ 67 lks to same line between old corner
