# Budget Order 2023-46 COMMUNITY JUSTICE – Treatment Court

The <u>**Treatment Court Program**</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires a decrease in Materials & Services of \$25,000 and an increase in Transfers Out of \$25,000.

## Budget Order 2023-48 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT – Economic Development Reserve

The <u>Economic Development Reserve Program</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Materials & Services of 1,000,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$1,000,000.

Budget Order 2023-51 GIS EQUIPMENT RESERVE

The <u>**GIS Equipment Reserve Program**</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Materials & Services of \$5,000 and a decrease in Capital Outlay of \$5,000.00.

Budget Order 2023-52 COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT RESERVE

The <u>Communication Equipment Program</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Materials & Services of \$5,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$5,000.

Budget Order 2023-53 STIMULUS RESERVE

The <u>Stimulus Reserve Program</u> requires a Transfer of Appropriation to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Materials & Services of \$1,000,000, an increase in Capital Outlay of \$250,000, an increase in Transfers Out of \$250,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$1,500,000.
