WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners has adopted a Burn Ordinance, codified at Chapter 91 of the Umatilla County Code of Ordinances, and Smoke Management Ordinance, codified at Chapter 95 of the Umatilla County Code of Ordinances, to regulate the open burning within certain areas of Umatilla County;

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners may prohibit burning based on general fire safety conditions, as confirmed by Section 91.06(D)(3) and 95.04(5)(E);

WHEREAS due to dry conditions and the need to prevent uncontrolled burns, a temporary ban on non-agricultural burning was implemented on July 1, 2023, under Order No. BCC2023-031;

WHEREAS conditions have improved with some precipitation and cooler weather, sufficient to allow burning.

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Commissioners orders that the ban on all non-agricultural burning is lifted effective 11:59 p.m., October 4, 2023, within the unincorporated areas of the county that are under the jurisdiction of the Board of Commissioners.
