### 2024-2025 Supplemental Budgets

Scheduled for April 03, 2024

Eighteen Supplemental Budgets are scheduled for consideration on April 03, 2024. The orders under consideration are attached and referenced by order number for your convenience.

## 

Budget Order 2024-23 **GENERAL FUND: General County** 

The <u>General County Program</u> requires a supplemental budget to appropriate funding not known at adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Federal Revenue of \$250,000, an increase in Materials & Service of \$80,000 and an increase in Contingency of \$170,000.

Budget Order 2024-25 **GENERAL FUND: Assessment** 

The <u>Assessment Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$10,000, an increase in Federal Revenue of \$15,000 and an increase in Materials & Services of \$25,000.

Budget Order 2024-30 **GENERAL FUND: Public Health Administration** 

The <u>Public Health Administration Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$30,000, a decrease in State Revenue of \$350,000, an increase in Federal Revenue of \$100,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$170,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$390,000.

Budget Order 2024-31 Harris Park

The <u>Harris Park Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$30,000, an increase in Personnel Services of \$10,000 and an increase in Contingency of \$20,000.

Budget Order 2024-32 Law Library

The <u>Law Library Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in State Revenue of \$8,000 and an increase in Materials & Services of \$8,000.

## Budget Order 2024-33 Community Developmental Disabilities

The <u>Community Developmental Disabilities Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$240,000, an increase in Local Revenue of \$75,000, an increase in Federal Revenue of \$27,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$27,000, an increase in Capital Outlay of \$110,000 and an increase in Contingency of \$205,000.

#### Budget Order 2024-34 Community Justice

The <u>Community Justice Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$160,000, an increase in Capital Outlay of \$30,000, and an increase in Contingency of \$130,000.

#### Budget Order 2024-35 Community Justice: Justice Reinvestment

The <u>Justice Reinvestment Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$160,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$120,000, and an increase in Contingency of \$40,000.

#### Budget Order 2024-37 **Economic Development**

The <u>Economic Development Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$50,000, an increase in State Revenue of \$12,000 and an increase in Materials & Services of \$62,000.

Budget Order 2024-39 County Fair

The <u>County Fair Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase Beginning Cash of \$45,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$82,000, and a decrease in Contingency of \$37,000.

Budget Order 2024-40 County School Program

The <u>County School Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$11,000 and an increase in Materials & Services of \$11,000.

Budget Order 2024-41 Victims & Witnesses - CFA

The <u>Victims & Witnesses - CFA Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$81,000 and an increase in Materials & Services of \$81,000.

Budget Order 2024-42 **Mediation** 

The <u>Mediation Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires a decrease in Beginning Cash of \$20,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$30,000 and a decrease in Contingency of \$50,000.

Budget Order 2024-43 Local Distribution

The <u>Local Distribution Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$1,727,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$1,400,000 and an increase in Contingency of \$327,000.

Budget Order 2024-44 Central Water Project

The <u>Central Water Project Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Local Revenue of \$5,600,000, an increase in State Revenue of \$5,400,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$18,000,000 and a decrease in Capital Outlay of \$7,000,000.

Budget Order 2024-45 **Dispatch Reserve** 

The <u>Dispatch Reserve Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$80,000, an increase in Materials & Services of \$50,000 and an increase in Contingency of \$30,000.

Budget Order 2024-46 **PERS – Personnel Reserve** 

The <u>PERS – Personnel Reserve Program</u> requires a Supplemental Budget to appropriate funding not known at the adoption of the budget. This requires an increase in Beginning Cash of \$3,200,000, an increase in Local Revenue of \$300,000 and an increase in Contingency of \$3,500,000.

Budget Order 2024-47 Fleet Management
