Spring 2025 Community and Economic Development Grant Review Committee Meeting Notes – May 20, 2025

Attendees: Wesley Koklich (City of Milton Freewater), Dustin Schock (City of Ukiah), Tammie Williams (City of Echo), Maria Duron (City of Hermiston), Bob Waldher (Community Development Director), Commissioner Dan Dorran (ex-officio)

The meeting began with a welcome and introductions from committee members.

Bob Waldher provided an overview of the grant program and outlined committee member responsibilities. It was discussed that grant funding decisions would be based on funding availability and consensus from committee members. Bob noted that not all of the money had to be spent each cycle and remaining funding could roll-over to future cycles if necessary. He also reminded the committee that grant funding should go to projects that enhance economic development and community livability. Events will not be funded through the program.

Final reports from previous grant recipients were shared with the group.

It was shared that approximately \$100,000 was available this cycle.

Each grant application was reviewed and discussed among committee members. After reviewing each of the projects and group discussion a recommendation was made to fund all of the applications received (see table on previous sheet for funding amounts). Dustin made a motion to recommend approval by the board of commissioners. The motion was seconded by Maria and the motion passed.
