WHEREAS, pursuant to a General Judgment Foreclosing Tax Lien of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Umatilla, case number 19CV41813, signed by the court on December 6, 2019, and recorded as Instrument No. 2019-6940376 in the Umatilla County Records, in a suit in which Umatilla County, Oregon, was plaintiff, and Manuel Arteaga, et al, were defendants, the property known as Umatilla County Tax Lot 5N2815-BD-00900, as described below, was sold subject to redemption to Umatilla County, Oregon; and

WHEREAS the said real property had been held by Umatilla County, Oregon, for the period of 2 years from and after the date of the judgment and decree of foreclosure, and on December 28, 2021, Umatilla County was conveyed the real property, by Deed recorded at Instrument No. 2021-7340234, Umatilla County Records; and

WHEREAS ORS 275.180 provides that the Board of Commissioners may at any time, without the publication of any notice, sell and convey to the record owner any property acquired by the county for delinquent taxes for not less than the amount of taxes and interest accrued and charged against the property at the time the county acquired the property, plus interest at the rate of six percent per annum from the date of acquisition; and

WHEREAS Umatilla County will receive funds in an amount which is equal to the amount of taxes and interest accrued against the property, plus interest, and the request to re-acquire the property by the record owner.

## NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Pursuant to ORS 275.180, Umatilla County will convey the below described property to Jose Mora, which was acquired by Umatilla County for delinquent taxes, for the amount of \$6,500.

2. The Board of Commissioners is authorized to execute a deed to Jose Mora, conveying the following described property, subject to all water rights of way and roads, easements, and liens or claims arising out of any assessment for a local improvement levied by any municipal corporation, and any title or equity of the municipal corporation predicated on or growing out of any such lien or assessment:

Lot 19, Block 1, McNary Townsite Division No. 3, an Addition to the City of Umatilla, Umatilla County, Oregon.
