## CO-ADOPTING REVISIONS TO THE CITY OF UKIAH COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE

- WHEREAS, The City of Ukiah has recently adopted revisions to its comprehensive plan and development ordinance; and
- WHEREAS, The revisions were made in order to meet the requirement of a Plan Update in lieu of a periodic review by LCDC; and
- WHEREAS, The City has requested the County co-adopt these revisions so as to insure consistency of standards between the county and city areas within the urban growth area; and
- WHEREAS, The Umatilla County Planning Commission reviewed the revisions on December 1, 1994 and unanimously recommended that the changes be co-adopted; and
- WHEREAS, The Umatilla County Board of Commissioners held a duly advertised public hearing on December 15, 1994, at which time no opposition was raised; and
- WHEREAS, Immediately following the hearing, the Board of Commissioners voted to co-adopt the City of Ukiah comprehensive plan and development ordinance revisions.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained that said revisions are hereby coadopted for application within the Ukiah urban growth area.

BE IT ALSO ORDAINED that an "emergency" exists in order for these revisions to be applicable immediately, so as to conform with the City's adoption.
