 which is herewith submitted, and they respectfully recommend  
 that the said road as herewith reported be opened for public travel

 point on the County Road leading from the Studson Bay farm  
 up Dry Creek to the town of Weston Wasatcha County Oregon

Set initial round fir post capable of squaring 4 inches  
 and marked and inclosed as required by law at a point  
 where the above described road crosses the line running  
 South through the center of Sec. 23 in T. 5 N. R. 34 E

Courses	Distances	Remarks
S 71° E	80 ch.	Set 1 mile stake as required by law
S 71° E	80 ch.	Set 2 mile " " " "
S 71° E	80 ch.	Set 3 mile " " " "
S 71° E	50 ch.	Set angle stake in lowest ground brushy thicket bears S 71° E about 3 ch.
S	25 ch.	Set 4 mile stake as law directs
S	35 ch.	Set Rock 6 x 12 in. and changed course
E	45 ch.	Set 5 mile stake according to law
S 64 1/2° E	80 ch.	Set 6 mile post in rock mound
S 64 3/4° E	80 ch.	Set 7 mile " as law directs unchanged course
S	32 ch.	Set angle stake near traveled road below or north of the town of Weston about one mile
S 38° E	45 ch.	Set 8 mile post as the law requires changed course
S 40° E	15 ch.	Set termination as law requires near the millon School house.
