NOW ON THIS DAY this matter coming on to be heard, this being
the time and place for final decision of the Court upon said matter,
and

IT APPEARING that due and lawful advertisement of the final
hearings have been given by the posting of three certified copies of
the resolution of this Court declaring its intention to vacate such
road, in three public places and in the vicinity of said road which
is proposed to be vacated and also by the posting of a certified copy
of such resolution on the bulletin board at the West Door of the County
Court House in Pendleton, Oregon, being the place of holding the
County Court, and all for at least thirty days prior to the date of
hearing, and

IT APPEARING that due proof of the posting of said Resolutions
is on file herein, and that such affidavit is before the Court, and
it appearing that no objections has been made or filed to such propos-
ed vacation and that said road so proposed to be vacated is not useful
as part of the general road system of Umatilla County and that such
road will not be in the future useful as part of the general road
system and is not of sufficient public benefit to warrant the same be-
ing maintained by the County.

IT IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that such por-
tion of said County Road No. 164, is useless and dangerous to maintain
and is of no value to individuals or to the general public and is use-
less as part of the road system of Umatilla County, and that the pub-
lic will be benefitted by its vacation and the same is hereby VACATED.

WE THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are freeholders of said Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the road district, or districts, where said road is to be laid out, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be ~~VACATED~~ ~~and established~~ a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the Quarter Section corner on the north side of Section 4, Township 3 North, Range 34 East, W.M., thence South along the north and south center line of said Section 4 to the Northwest Corner Blk. 26, Holdman's West Addition to the Town of Adams. Said road being a portion of County Road No. 164.

We respectfully petition that the portion of County Road No. 164, above described, be vacated at such time as the new road known as the Sand Hollow Market Road is opened for travel.

We respectfully show that there is no public necessity for said road, in that, the new road known as the Sand Hollow Market Road will care for the traffic formerly carried by the said road.
