

PETITION

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON, FOR UMATILLA COUNTY:

I, the undersigned, your petitioner, a freeholder of said Umatilla County, Oregon, residing in the road district where said road is located, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be altered and changed, [a portion of a County Road crossing the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 31, Township 3 North, Range 36 East, W.M., known and designated as County Road No. 750, also as Reservation Road No. 4, Said Road No. 750 to be altered, changed and turned from its present location to follow the following described center line; Beginning at a point in the center of said County Road No. 750 at the west end of the Meacham Creek bridge, thence westerly 20 feet north of and parallel to the north right of way line of the Oregon Washington Railroad and Navigation Co's. railroad to a point 200 feet east of the west line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 31, thence westerly to a point in the center of County Road No. 750 and on the west line of the said Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 31, Township 3 North, Range 36 East, W.M.

Said road to be forty feet in width, twenty feet wide on each side of the above described center line.

All of the lands in question traversed by the present Road No. 750 and the proposed changed and altered line are owned by your petitioner.

The proposed change will not increase the distance or gradients and will improve the alignment of said County Road No. 750.
