

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Grantee has applied for a grant of an easement under the Act of October 13, 1964 (78 Stat. 1089, 16 U.S.C. 532-538), for a road over certain lands or assignable easements owned by the United States in the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, and administered by the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture.

NOW THEREFORE, Grantor does hereby grant to Grantee an easement for a public road and highway, hereinafter defined as the right-of-way and over and across those certain easements acquired in the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, from the following:

Yellow Jacket Rd. No. 5415

Easement from Georgia M. Etter, a widow; Raymond B. Rugg and Barbara Jean Rugg, husband and wife; Milton Joseph Carter and Irene Carter, husband and wife; Jack E. Etter and Marjorie Jean Etter, husband and wife; Bill Etter and Elizabeth Catherine Etter, husband and wife, dated May 16, 1968, recorded June 24, 1968, in Deed Book 294, Page 429, Umatilla County, Oregon.

Easement from Yvonne E. Sager, a widowed woman, dated April 27, 1968, recorded August 30, 1968, in Deed Book 296, Page 314, Umatilla County, Oregon.

Easement from H. A. Main and Violet Louise Main, husband and wife, dated July 9, 1968 recorded July 11, 1968, in Deed Book 294, Page 587, Umatilla County, Oregon.

The right-of-way is shown and specifically described on Exhibits A through $\ensuremath{\mathfrak{D}}$ attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The word "right-of-way" when used herein means said strip of land whether or not there is an existing road or highway located thereon. Except where it is defined more specifically, the word "highway" shall mean roads or highways now existing or hereafter constructed on the right-of-way or any segment of such roads or highways.

This grant is made subject to the following terms, provisions, and conditions:

- 1. Outstanding valid claims, if any, existing on the date of this grant.
- 2. The Grantee does by the acceptance of this document covenant and agree for itself, its assigns, and its successors in interest to the property herein granted or any part thereof, that the covenant set forth below shall attach to and run with the land:
 - (a) That the Grantee shall operate the described property and its appurtenant areas and its buildings and facilities whether or not on the land therein granted as a public road, in full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all requirements imposed by or pursuant to the regulations issued thereunder by the Department of Agriculture and in effect on the date of this document to the end that no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, sex, color, religion, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any programs or activities provided thereon; and
 - (b) That the United States shall have the right to judicial enforcement of these covenants not only as to the Grantee, its successors and assigns, but also as to lessees and licensees doing business or extending services under contractual or other arrangements on the land therein conveyed.

The Chief, Forest Service, may terminate this easement, or any segment thereof, (1) by consent of the Grantee, (2) by condemnation, or (3) after a five (5) year period of nonuse, by a determination to cancel after notification and opportunity for hearing as prescribed by law.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Grantor, by its Director of Lands, Pacific Northwest Region, Forest Service, has executed this easement pursuant to the delegation of authority to the Chief, Forest Service 7 CFR 2.42, and the delegation of authority by the Chief, Forest Service, dated August 29, 1984 (49 FR 34283), on the day and year first above written.




