

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

T 4N , R 37E. , W.M.

Corner Code No. Z-17

Note: Monument marked as shown below

History of original corner establishment:

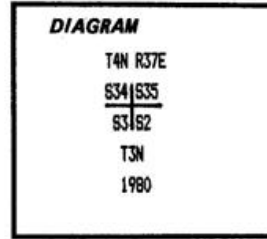
This corner was originally established by George S. Pershin, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under Contract No. 304, dated September 19, 1878.

The original notes state:

Set pine post on West slope for corner to sections 2, 3, 34, and 35 from which:

- A fir 24 in. diam. bears N 17° E, 38 links.
- A fir 10 in. diam. bears S 42° E, 38 links.
- A fir 22 in. diam. bears S 40° W, 50 links.
- A fir 22 in. diam. bears N 40° W, 53 links.

In 1980, this corner was recovered and re-monumented by John P. Lee, Cadastral Surveyor for the Bureau of Land Management. Field notes for the re-monumentation are on file in County Survey Records.

Compass Declination: 18.0°

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 3 1/4" brass cap on a 2 1/2" galvanized iron pipe protruding 6" out of ground from which:

- A 36" white fir snag bears S 40°W, 19.8' with a chopped open face. (original bearing tree)
- A 18" Englemann spruce bears N 17 3/4°W, 34.7' with visible scribes on a partly healed blaze. (BLM bearing tree).
- A 11" white fir bears N 18 1/2°W, 42.6' with visible scribes on a partly healed blaze. (BLM bearing tree).
- A 22" Englemann spruce bears S 51 1/2°W, 12.9' with visible scribes on a partly healed blaze. (BLM bearing tree).
- A 16" Englemann spruce bears S 33 3/4°E, 18.8' with visible scribes on a partly healed blaze. (BLM bearing tree).

There is a steel fence post to the South with a Land Corner Monument sign, and a National Forest Boundary sign attached.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

We maintained corner by mounding with earth.

All bearing trees have bearing tree or bearing object signs attached.
